PRESIDENT'S OFFICE

Here is the information you requested on Flying Disc Courses. Please excuse the long delay. Another member of our club had volunteered to get this information and failed to do so after several months. Towards the end of last semester I decided to acquire the information myself. I eventually contacted Michael Conger, head of the Professional Disc Golf Association (P.D.G.A.) on the East Coast. Mr. Conger put me in touch with Ed Headrix, head of the P.D.G.A. nationally, who sent me this information.

Enclosed is a booklet that contains locations and phone numbers of 256 flying disc courses in the United States as of 1984. Also enclosed is a descriptive color pamphlet describing disc golf. Please note the golf recreation study and Gallop Poll ~~and~~ results. The recreation study reveals that the La Mirada course was utilized an average of 246% more than La Mirada's 12 tennis courts which cost 96% more than the 18 hole golf course. The Gallop Poll

points out that Frisbee disc sports ranked 8th nationwide among leisure activities. Also enclosed are a group of letters to the PDGA from park systems expressing satisfaction with their disc golf courses. Many of the letters point out that the courses reduced vandalism and were often kept clean by the players themselves. Also enclosed is an article clipped out of the Washington Post.

I realize that phase one of the Battleground complex is already upon us but you may want to consider a course during a later phase. I leave it up to you to make a decision on a course. To reiterate a thought from my previous letter, I would like to emphasize that a course should be built to help attract students to our school as opposed to appeasing our current flying disc competitors. You are in a position to set a nationwide precedent by funding a "College" pole hole course. Five years from now such an opportunity may no longer be open. Please contact me if you reach an absolute decision either way.

If you decide to build a course,
I am familiar enough with the woods
